



### **Paperbark Maples shine in gardens and streetscapes**

Exfoliating bark and delicate, dark green leaves in clusters of three are among the many attributes of this versatile small shade tree. Hardy through USDA Zone 5, it is a compact, ornamental street tree when grown as a single stem tree.

Paperbark maple is pest and disease-resistant, and surprisingly drought tolerant. Adding to its all-season appeal is long-lasting, brilliant red fall color.

Unique, reddish brown bark exfoliates in paper-thin curls to reveal cinnamon-orange bark beneath. Multi-stem trees, or single stem trees planted in informal groupings and sweeping groves, multiply the beauty of its unique bark.

Well-branched VigorLiner® trees with husky trunks, grown in #5 RediRoot™ (air pruning) containers, are great for fall planting in the field or in containers. Garden centers will find them to be an eye-catching retail item when their deep green leaves turn to bright red-orange in autumn.
