Malus 'JFS-KW5'

This new tree is a four-season beauty. In spring, Royal Raindrops has pretty pink flowers like the tree in the large photo above. After the flowers fade, small red fruits start to form. (And the fruit stays on the tree instead of littering your drive.) In summer, deep-purple lobed leaves look almost like a Japanese maple. The leaves change to the red-orange in the inset in fall. Berries decorate the branches all winter long.

At 20 feet tall with an upright habit, Royal Raindrops can fit even in a small garden. With its great disease resistance, this beautiful tree will be around for years to come.
