

# Bald Cypress

*(Taxodium distichum)*



Named a “Great Plant for the Great Plains” by the Nebraska Statewide Arboretum, and a “Great Plant Pick” for the Pacific Northwest, Bald Cypress thrives in the Heartland and beyond. Native to wetlands, it has proven adaptable to dry, compacted urban soils. Deciduous, needlelike green leaves turn orange-tan before dropping in autumn. Bare root trees, as well as trees established in #3 Air Root containers, are listed on Page 7. An “Oklahoma Proven<sup>®</sup>” award winner, its symmetrical beauty is reflected in Oklahoma City’s Bricktown canal.
