Royal Star Magnolia

is an ideal multi-stem magnolia for smaller spaces, eventually attaining a height of 15 feet and spread of 10 feet. Prior to the leaves emerging in spring, pink buds open to fragrant, pure white, 3 to 4-inch flowers. Green summer foliage gives way to bronze-yellow leaves in the fall.

Merrill Magnolia

(*Magnolia x loebneri* 'Merrill') flowers resemble a puffy white cloud afloat in the landscape. Each 3 to 3½ inch flower is composed of 15 narrow white petals. This cultivar flowers reliably and heavily at an early age. Multi-stem and tree forms are available, on Pages 3 and 7.
